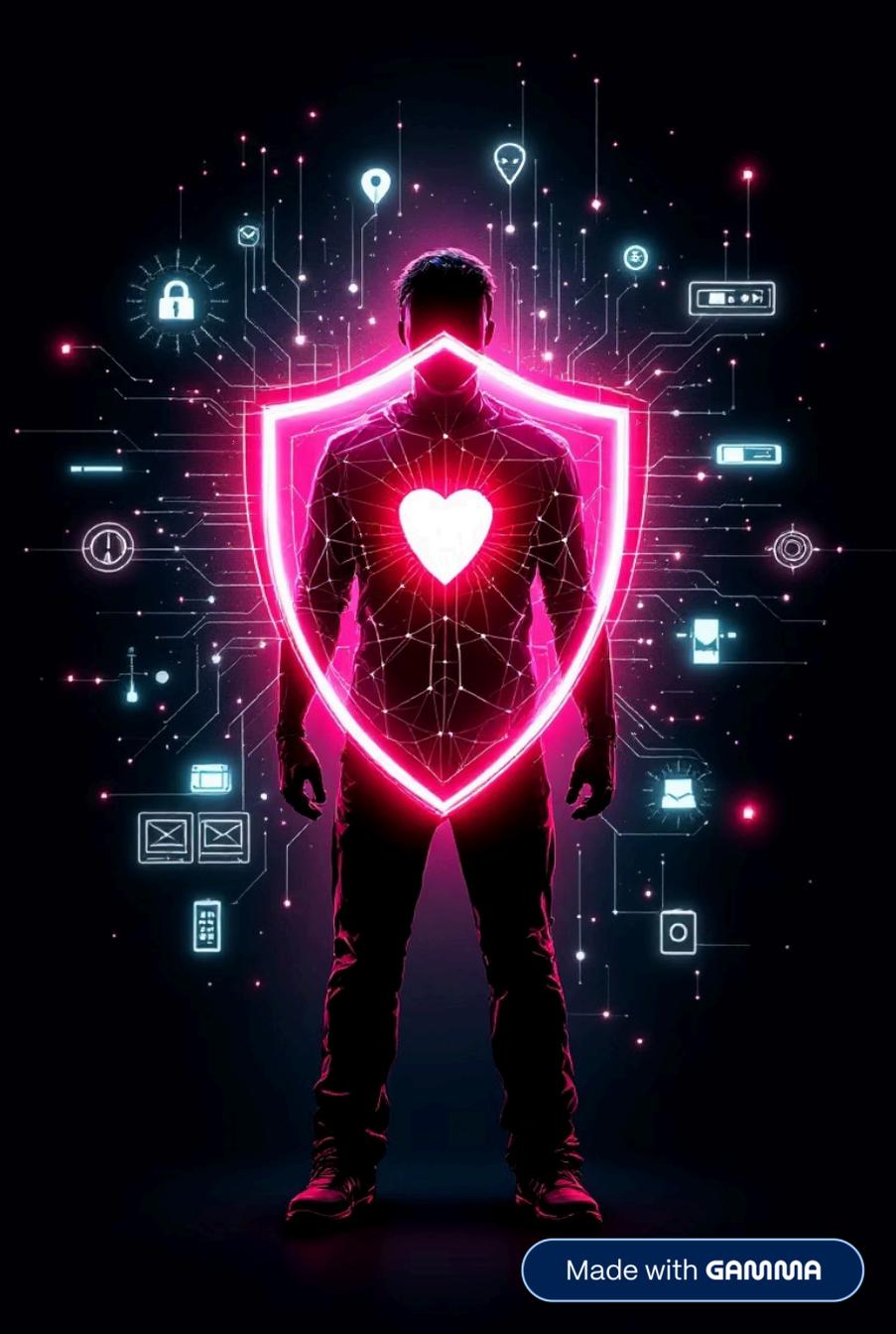

Why We Need More Than Technology

1 The Hard Truth

Technical defenses alone aren't enough to protect your organization. Firewalls and antivirus software can't stop an employee from clicking a malicious link or sharing credentials.

How Attackers Target Human Behaviour

Cybercriminals have evolved beyond brute force technical attacks. They now use sophisticated **social engineering** techniques designed to exploit predictable human behaviours.

Fear & Urgency

Creating panic with messages about "account compromise" or "immediate action required" to bypass your rational thinking

Trust & Authority

Impersonating trusted figures like your CEO, IT department, or familiar brands to gain compliance

Curiosity & Reward

Baiting with too-good-to-be-true offers or intriguing content that tempts you to click without thinking

Top Employee Mistakes: The Careless Click

The Danger Zone

Phishing emails remain the **number one attack vector** because they work. A single misguided click can compromise your entire organization.

The average employee receives 121 emails daily, making quick decisions about each one. Attackers need just one moment of inattention to succeed.



- ⊗ **Real-world impact:** In 2023, 74% of successful breaches began with a phishing email that an employee clicked without proper scrutiny.

Top Employee Mistakes: Password Vulnerabilities

62%

Reuse Passwords

Most employees use the same password across multiple accounts, creating a domino effect if one is compromised.

21%

Share Credentials

Of employees admit to sharing passwords with colleagues for convenience.

73%

Use Weak Passwords

Continue using easily guessable passwords despite knowing better security practices.

Your password strength directly impacts your organization's security posture. Even one weak link can compromise enterprise-grade protection systems.

Top Employee Mistakes: Oversharing Information



The Silent Threat

Information leakage often happens quietly, without us even noticing. Small actions can expose valuable details to outsiders:

- **Casual conversations in public spaces** – discussing confidential matters where others can overhear.
- **Innocent workplace photos** – a picture may reveal documents, whiteboards, or screens with sensitive data.
- **Oversharing on social media** – posting about projects, clients, or company tools gives attackers useful clues.
- **Unlocked or unattended screens** – leaving information visible even for a short time can be enough.

Individually, these moments may seem harmless. But attackers are skilled at collecting small fragments and connecting them into a bigger picture. This creates targeted attacks that feel personal and convincing – making them harder to detect.

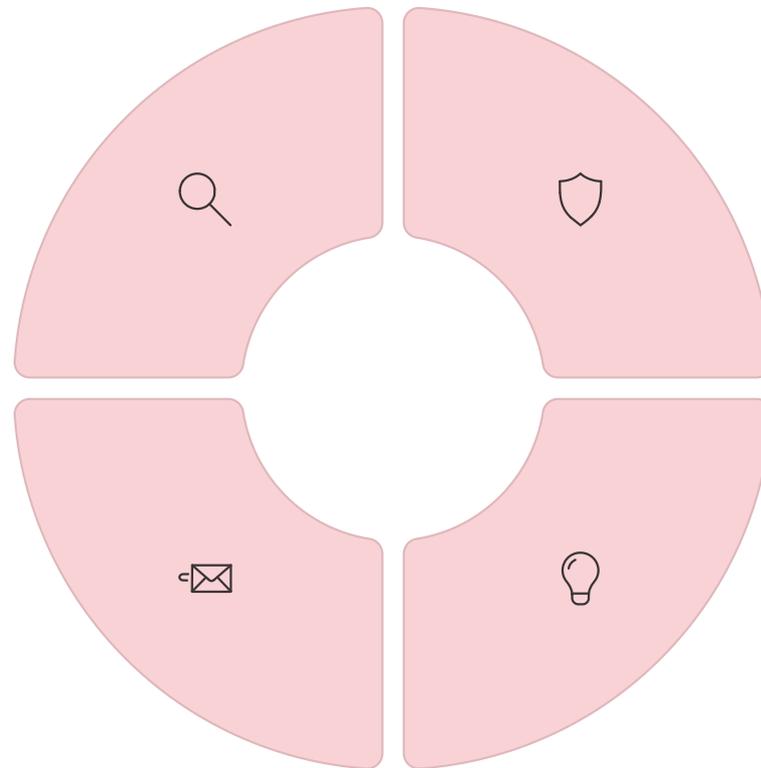
Knowledge is your strongest defense
